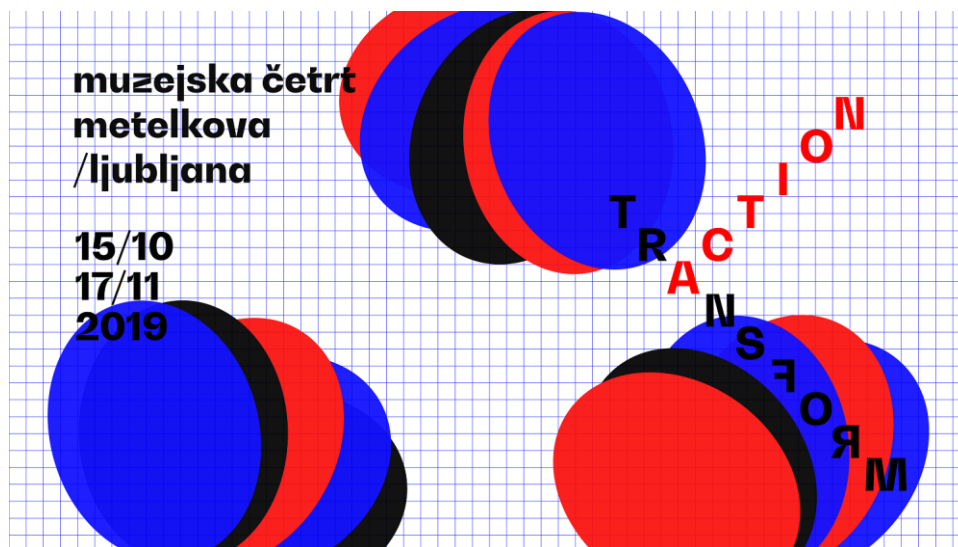

**About TRANS-FORM:ACTION**

**TRANSFORM** is an ambitious project on connecting art academies of South-East Europe which has been implemented biannually since 2009. It gives young creators a platform for a professional presentation in the framework of an international group exhibition and thereby significantly contributes to the development of international cooperation between higher education institutions in the field of visual arts.

The Academy of Fine Arts and Design of the University of Ljubljana (ALUO) has successfully participated in all foreign exhibitions of the project to date; in 2019, for the centennial of the University in Ljubljana, the ALUO took over the organisation and implementation of the exhibition and the accompanying event program in Ljubljana (in multiple locations: Museum of Contemporary Art Metelkova, National Museum of Slovenia – Metelkova, Slovene Ethnographic Museum, Night Window Display Gallery Pešak – ACC Metelkova City, Platform of the Museum Quarter at Metelkova Street).



In this year's exhibition, titled **TRANS-FORM:ACTION**, which will take place between October 15th and November 17th 2019, students from the academies in Ljubljana, Zagreb, Sophia, Bucharest, Skopje and Istanbul are participating.

The following events are taking place in the framework of the project:

- **4–15 October 2019**: a ten-day workshop titled **PLACE IN TRANSFORMATION** with select students from guest partner academies. Mentorship: Prof. Alen Ožbolt, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Uršula Berlot Pompe. - **8 October–11 November 2019**: exhibition titled **TRANSFORMATIONS**, a presentation of the short-listed proposals for the visual identity design of TRANS-FORM:ACTION, made by ALUO's graphic design students, at the TAM-TAM's Street Gallery at Vegova Street in Ljubljana.
